The Niagara Police Athletic League Soccer Club is pleased to introduce Futsal, a new indoor program, to the soccer playing youth of the community. Very simply, Futsal is a scaled down indoor version of outdoor soccer. The game is played using a specifically designed "low bounce" soccer ball to make it more controllable. The out of bounds are the sidelines of a basketball court, and the goals are 6'h X 10'w. Each team has four players plus a goalkeeper on the court at a time; substitutions are "on the fly" (similar to hockey).

The inaugural six week session will be limited to boys and girls ages 7 to 12. Play will be at the LaSalle Community Center located at 95th Street and Colvin Blvd. on Saturdays starting November 10, 2007. Registration is limited and preference will be given to 2007 participants in the Niagara PAL Summer Soccer Program, Fall 4X4 Program, and PAL travel team players. The league is limited to 6 "coed" teams ages 7-8-9 and six teams ages 10-11-12. The cost for the six week program is \$30. Each player will receive a league jersey. Sessions will consist of skills' training and a 40 minute game.

Registration will be at DeDee's Dairy (Niagara Falls Blvd & Tuscarora Road) on Saturday, October 27, from 12:00 to 2:00 p.m. Mail-in registration forms may be downloaded at www.niagara-soccer.com.
